

Curriculum Vitae 2018 of Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. Lutz F. Tietze

Lutz F. Tietze studied chemistry at the universities of Freiburg and Kiel, Germany and obtained his doctorate in 1968 in Kiel. He then worked as a research associate with Prof. G. Büchi at MIT, Cambridge, USA for two years and got his habilitation at the University of Münster in 1975. He got several calls as professor to different universities and has been professor and director of the Institute of Organic and Biomolecular Chemistry at the Georg-August-University in Göttingen since 1978. He has received many awards as the very prestigious Emil Fischer Gold medal of the German Chemical Society; the latest is the granting of a doctor honoris causa of the Georg-August-University-Göttingen in January 2018. He has about 480 scientific papers, 38 patents and six books to his name. His research focuses on the development of efficient and selective synthetic methods using domino reactions and the development of new selective anticancer agents employing monoclonal antibodies.
